30. APPROVAL OF MINUTES –

40. COMMISSIONER & AD HOC REPORTS

C van den Bosch has show coming up in July at Shift, and at Seattle Art Fair. He is also working with his students at school combining art and technology. DD Olson suggested we work with the maker space at EdCC

C Gutcheck announced an art show of the NW7 (of which C Hanson is a part) at Francis Anderson Center in Edmonds. C Hanson will also be part of the Edmonds Art Studio tour coming in September. This is also a way for us to find out how a studio tour works.

80.1 Mayor Nicola Smith – annual visit

Mayor spoke about going to Korean sister city Damyang. Trip was very successful. Got to visit the president’s residence called the Blue House. There will be a student exchange in a year or so. There is talk about art, architecture, economic exchanges in the future.

She also talked about having youth represented in advisory boards, either as their own board, or as members of various boards.

#### 80.2 Sound Transit Art Update (Barbara Luecke & Claudia Fitch)

South Transit presented some planning images for the Lynnwood Station. The train track will be 35 feet above ground. There will be a new garage, and 1900 parking spaces total at the station, which is 500 more than now. Estimated 16-20K daily riders, trains every 30 seconds. There will be more local buses bringing people to the station. 2 entrances, North & South. The gold accent color for the station is chosen from the Lynnwood brand. The station name is Lynnwood City Center.

Artist Claudia Fitch's existing sculpture "Shift" will be relocated. And together with a new iconic sculpture about 30 feet tall, will serve wayfinding functions. Fitch found inspiration from the hummingbird and plant life, and she plans to use neon as a nod to Lynnwood's past where businesses line Hwy 99 with their neon signs. The new work is a companion piece to Shift, a look to the future and coexistence of nature and city.

They are also exploring a new concept on the promenade from both entrances, placing a series of light boxes, where 2D images are projected, and rotated regularly. This is an opportunity for emerging artists' work.

98 artists were selected in Spring in an expansion pool, to work on smaller projects.

There will be a day lit stream to bring more nature to the station, a small bridge over the stream, and places to sit and enjoy nature.

There is an online open house, and an July 25 open house at the convention center.

#### 80.3 LOVE Lynnwood Projects / empowering co-creators (EGGS-plore Lynnwood)

C Lunsford shared a list of accomplishments by the EGGS-plore project, and asked other members to contribute additional ones. We raised nearly \$1900 from the auction.

#### 80.4 Traffic Signal Box – wrap (new projects)

CPC Wong showed a new mock up for the library box wrap, and asked for feedback.

#### 80.5 South Lynnwood Park – Placemaking

There is an open house on June 21, 6-7:30pm, to talk to neighbors. We hired an artist team to research the people and character of South Lynnwood.
