30. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – October 18th, 2016 minutes were approved as distributed.

40. COMMISSIONER & AD HOC REPORTS

- Com. Walsh reported that the Veteran’s Museum at Heritage Park is planning to have a soft opening in January.

80.1 2017 Activities

80.3 Updates: Signal Box wraps

CPC Wong showed the current design for the signal box wrap on Alderwood Mall Blvd & 40th near the interurban trail. The commissioners were concerned that the image of the trolley and bicycle did not look well next to each other. The commissioners suggested adding color to the trolley image so the two images would blend into each other rather than conflict.
