80. BUSINESS ITEMS

80.1 Mayor Nicola Smith

Mayor Smith commented on our work, and connections to other happenings in the city.

- The signal box wraps are really popular, hopes to keep them going. Acura dealership is great at helping Lynnwood, and may be a place to seek sponsorship.
- City will start work on possible annexation projects.
- Golf Course parking lot renovation project may qualify under public art ordinance.
- South Lynnwood project has many possibilities for art.
- People love the LOVE Lynnwood t-shirt.
- People also really like the art displays in City Hall, Mayor has gotten lots of good comments.
- When we start to build city center, we'd want to look at possible digital art
- Mayor likes the DiscoverLynnwood.com map project
- Lynnwood generates the most hotel/motel tax in Snohomish County
- Mayor Smith started an innovators gathering at City Hall, which has generated huge interests
- Think about art needs for older adults.

#### 80.2 Signal Box Wrap project

- Signal Box Wrap at Wilcox Park is completed. Ribbon Cutting is being scheduled.
- Working on box wrap at 212 + Hwy 99 with the fire protection theme. CPC Wong hopes it will be done by October, because we need to use the Snoh county grant by the end of the year.

#### 80.4 Wine Walk

C Gutcheck discussed with David LeClair that February 2018 would be a good time for wine walk. Feb 9 or 10 would be the best dates. CPC Wong emailed Sara to find out if any of those dates are available. We prefer Saturdays. We will be responsible for selling wine tickets & food tickets.

C Gutcheck & C Hanson were invited to Convention Center for wine sampling event and food pairing, to help them pick their wine offerings in 2018.

#### 80.5 Love Lynnwood projects (Eggs-plore Lynnwood)

The idea is a fun activity with 30 large artist designed eggs placed in the community for people to find. After the egg hunt, the eggs will be exhibited at city hall, and then auctioned off for a good cause. CPC Wong created a timeline for the project. We're working on a phone app & map. We decided that each artist will get a \$200 honorarium, and each business sponsorship will be \$250. The ArtWA grant of \$400 will pay for 20 artists. The city will pay for the blank eggs, and developing the app, and other costs and labor. We'll define a size limit. We will open the project to all WA state artists. C Lunsford suggested a liaison for the human services commission to get their help. C White volunteered. C Richards volunteered to talk with Rotary. We'll also want to talk with Chamber of Commerce
