**Art Egg completed by: February 25, 2018**



**What is the project?**

**We're looking for 30 creative people or teams to create large "art eggs".**

We will place 30 art eggs throughout the city, for the "EGGS-plore Lynnwood" Egg Hunt.

The places will include many Human Service Providers (eg Food Bank) and select business sponsors.

After the Egg Hunt, the eggs will be exhibited at Lynnwood City Hall. We will then auction off the eggs, and the proceeds will benefit human service providers.

**Why?**

Lynnwood is a "Great Deal More!" with a rich history that many people don't know about. In the 1920s, the many small farms here made up the nation's second largest egg producing region.

We want to create a fun & unique activity for our community to explore Lynnwood's great human service providers and local business. And showcase creative people.



**Who can apply?**

Creative people of all ages in WA State. Apply as an individual or as a group. Especially if you live, work, or play in Lynnwood, we'll love for you to apply.

**How to apply?**

**What happens after you apply?**

We will select 30 artists / creative people. A blank egg form can be provided or you may choose to create an egg from scratch that follows the design requirements. When the egg is completed and received, each creator will receive an honorarium of \$200. The egg will not be returned but will be auctioned off and proceeds will be donated to the human services providers.

**Design requirements:**

- It sits flat on large end of egg
- Size does not exceed 16(l) x 16(w) x 16(h), including any attached parts

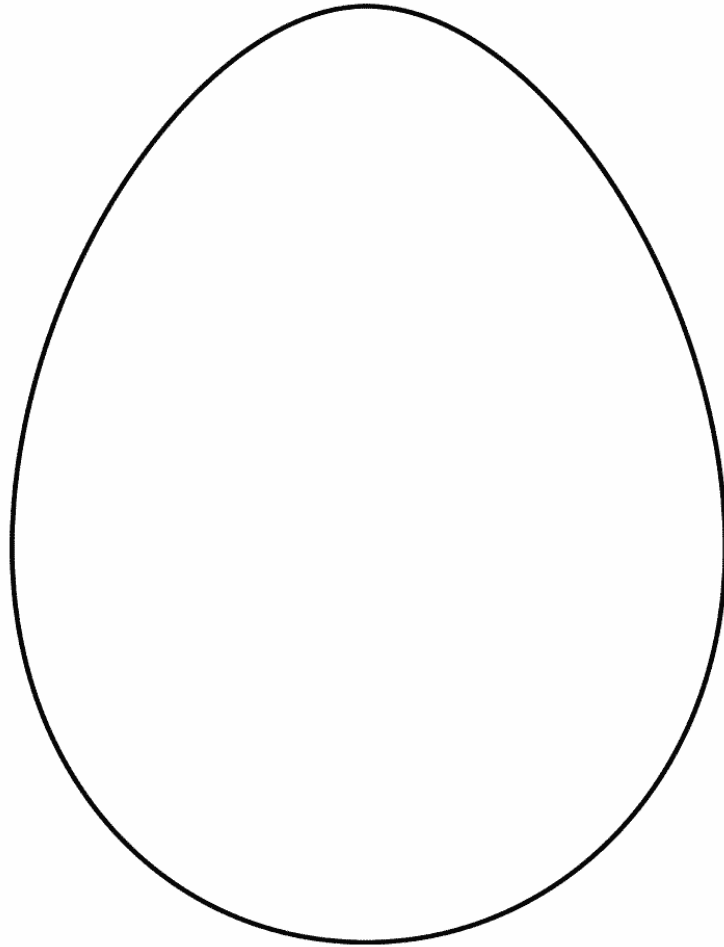
