

I LOVE Lynnwood: Sculpture Design – Call for Artists / Creative People

Lynnwood, WA is looking for artists, designers, architects, makers, and creative people to design an iconic sculpture based on the theme: **I LOVE Lynnwood**. We are asking you to create a **design idea** for a sculpture, not the real thing. We envision the large sculpture to be 40-50 feet wide, located at the Lynnwood Convention Center in its outdoor area near the intersection of 196th & 36th. We hope the sculpture will be visually appealing, become an iconic destination for the city, and encourage lots of interaction and photography. More info on pages 3 & 4.

Deadline: January 31, 2019

Eligibility: Open to anyone living in WA State. No entry fee. We encourage designers, architects, artists, makers, and creative people to apply.

Awards: Up to 5 finalists will be selected. Each will be awarded \$500 to create and present detailed designs and/or models, reflecting additional parameters given to finalists (See page 2). Winner will receive another award of \$2,000, to further enhance the design, and consult with our fabricator, and engineer.

Selection: A panel of art professionals and community members will choose finalists, using the following criteria:

- Strength of past work
- Answer to THE QUESTION: **Why would you like us to select you?**

Design requirements:

Design must be one of the following four word-symbol combinations:

- I Love Lynnwood
- Love Lynnwood
- I ♥ Lynnwood
- ♥ Lynnwood

Letters can stack, go along a straight line, or along a curve, at different levels, in caps, in lower case or combination, in different fonts, or in other words - let your imagination fly.

Information For Finalists

Finalists will create and present their detail designs to include:

- Drawings, Renderings, 3D mock ups, models
- Sizes / Dimensions (must be at least 4' high and 30' wide)
- Other parameters / specifications to be given to finalists
- Font (existing or original), Color, Material choices
- Lighting
- Location
- Description

Finalists' designs will be juried based on the following criteria:

- Visual appeal
- Potential to become a local iconic destination
- How it encourages interaction, photography
- Ease of production / fabrication

Call Rules (Additional)

By entering this Call, "Applicant" (meaning applicant and if under-age, their legal guardian), agrees to be bound by the call rules and the decisions of the City of Lynnwood Partners* ("Partners"), which are final and binding in all respects and cannot be challenged or appealed.

Applicant certifies that their Submission is of their own creation and does not infringe on the rights of any third parties.

Partners may require applicant to submit additional material for scanning or photography. Partners are not responsible for the failure of any Submissions not received. Partners reserve the right to pick no Finalists or Winner from the Submissions.

OWNERSHIP AND LICENSE: All **Finalist** Call related materials, including submission entries, designs, and statements (collectively, "Submission") becomes the property of the Partners and will not be acknowledged or returned. The copyright in any Submission shall remain the property of the Applicant, but entry into this Call constitutes Applicant's irrevocable and perpetual permission and consent, without further compensation or attribution, to use, reproduce, print, publish, transmit, distribute, sell, perform, adapt, enhance, modify, or display such Submission for any purpose, including but not limited to editorial, advertising, trade, commercial, and publicity purposes by the Partners, in any and all media now in existence or hereafter invented throughout the universe. Partners and/or others authorized by the Partners shall have the right to edit, adapt, and modify the Submission.
