



**ORDINANCE NO. 2948**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR PROJECT FUND 011-69, VEHICLE PROCESSING BAY EVIDENCE STORAGE BUILDING PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, upon the sale of the joint shop to the City of Mountlake Terrace in the year 2010, the Lynnwood Police Department no longer has an area to conduct secured vehicle searches; and

WHEREAS, the Project will construct a vehicle processing bay and evidence processing rooms in the Lynnwood Evidence Storage Building located at 7014 196<sup>th</sup> Street SW, Lynnwood, WA, 98036; and

WHEREAS, the Project will be used by the Lynnwood Police Department to conduct searches of seized vehicles in a secured indoor environment and process evidence; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to spend the appropriations for the Project in the year 2012; and

WHEREAS, the 2011-12 City budget anticipated funding various facility improvements under Fund 105, of which the improvements to be completed by the Project are eligible expenses; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Appropriation:

A. The sum of \$150,000.00 is hereby appropriated, to the extent not previously appropriated, for completion of the Project, as follows:



Section 4. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.


