



ORDINANCE NO. 2953

AN ORDINANCE SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE #2918, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE SCRIBER LAKE AERATION RETROFIT & FLOATING ISLAND PROJECT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the Scriber Lake Aeration Retrofit & Floating Island Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities plan as project numbers 200900129 and 200900130 and

WHEREAS, in 2010 the City sold utility bonds for various projects, one of which is the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to spend the appropriations for the Project over the next two years; and

WHEREAS, the Project will study the lake's water quality and formulate strategies to improve water quality; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2918 previously authorized project funding from Fund 441/419; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Appropriation:

- A. The sum of \$112,300 is hereby appropriated, to the extent not previously appropriated, for completion of the Project, as follows:

Section 3: If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4: This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.






