



ORDINANCE NO. 3076

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR REBUILD OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT 196TH STREET SW AND SCRIBER LAKE ROAD; AND SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE 3046, WHICH SUPERSEDED ORDINANCE 2959; AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES IN PROJECT FUND 309; AND AUTHORIZING FUNDING TRANSFERS, ALLOCATIONS, AND REIMBURSEMENTS FROM FUNDS 199 AND 331; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement program as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, reconstruction of the traffic signal at 196th Street SW and Scriber Lake Road (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities plan as project number ST2006091A; and

WHEREAS, the existing Project intersection is the last of the obsolete span wire traffic signal systems and does not meet current design/safety standards; and

WHEREAS, the City has established funding from fund 199 and fund 331 to rebuild existing traffic signals that have gone beyond their serviceable life; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a \$300,000 Federal grant for the construction phase of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 2959;

WHEREAS, the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3046;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Appropriation:






