



ORDINANCE NO. 3105

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE
CRITICAL AREAS REGULATIONS UPDATE AND BASE MAPPING;
AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND
SUMMARY PUBLICATION.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the Growth Management Act requires local jurisdictions to adopt development regulations that protect critical areas designated in accordance with RCW 36.70A.170; and

WHEREAS, wetlands are required to be identified and rated according to the Washington State Wetland Identification and Delineation Manual and the updated 2014 Washington State Wetland Rating System for Western Washington prepared by the Washington State Department of Ecology; and

WHEREAS, this Project will provide technical assistance in drafting and adopting updated critical areas regulations and base mapping that comply with state, federal, and local requirements, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Appropriation:


