ORDINANCE NO. 3109

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE 2843, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR 36TH/35TH AVENUE WEST ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES IN PROJECT FUND 317; AND AUTHORIZING FUNDING TRANSFERS, ALLOCATIONS, AND REIMBURSEMENTS FROM FUND 331, FUND 440, FUND 110, FUND 411, GRANT FUNDS, MITIGATION FUNDS, AND SNOHOMISH COUNTY FUNDS; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement program as a part of the City's Transportation Improvement Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 36th/35th Avenue W Road Improvement Project from Maple Road to Highway 99 (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities Plan as project number ST2003056A; and

WHEREAS, the Project will accommodate the growing traffic demands and enhance public safety by providing intersection enhancements and pavement, pedestrian and bicycle improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City and Snohomish County have jurisdiction over specific segments of the roadway corridor and have received a \$1,750,000 STPUL Federal Grant for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and Snohomish County have entered into an Interlocal Agreement to complete ninety percent (90%) design and right-of-way documentation for the Project; and

WHEREAS, ninety percent (90%) design has been completed for the Project and the City now desires to complete design and the right-of-way phases for the portion of the Project located within the City's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously approved Project financial plans in Ordinances 2779 and 2843;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Appropriation:

A. The estimated costs of the Project are provided in detail on the attached Financial Plan dated 2/10/2015, and summarized as follows:






