



ORDINANCE NO. 3117

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.48 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; AMENDING SECTION 2.48.185 RELATING TO PAY GRADE CLASSIFICATION FOR REGULAR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD NOT OTHERWISE COVERED UNDER A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


