ORDINANCE NO. 3123

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING FUNDING FOR THE BIKELINK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES IN PROJECT FUND 128; AND AUTHORIZING FUNDING TRANSFERS, ALLOCATIONS, AND REIMBURSEMENTS FROM GRANT FUNDS; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement program as a part of the City's Transportation Improvement Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the BikeLink Improvement Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities Plan as project number 201400164; and

WHEREAS, the Project will serve to improve access to safer cycling by all community residents, increase ridership, and generally improve the health of community members upon completion of the regional bicycle network.; and

WHEREAS, in the year 2014, the Cities of Lynnwood, Edmonds and Mountlake Terrace were jointly awarded \$1,900,000 in grant funds from the Verdant Health Commission to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW (Interlocal Cooperation Act) permits local government units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other government entities on the basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner pursuant to forms of governmental organizations that will accord best

with geographic, economic population, and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
