



ORDINANCE NO. 3124

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE RECREATION CENTER PARKING LOT EXPANSION; AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES IN PROJECT FUND 322; AND AUTHORIZING FUNDING TRANSFERS, ALLOCATIONS, AND REIMBURSEMENTS FROM FUND 333; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Center Parking Lot Expansion project is included in the City's 2014-2019 6-Year Capital Facilities Plan as project number 201200163; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Center current parking facilities is experiencing peak use hours parking congestion: and

WHEREAS, the proposed parking lot is located north and west of the Recreation Center and west of Fire Station 15: and

WHEREAS, expanding the parking lot will provide additional parking stalls to help with peak usage of the Recreation facility: and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will add approximately 35 parking stalls: and

WHEREAS, funding for this project has been identified to come from Fund 333 – Capital Development Fund, now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Appropriation:
