



ORDINANCE NO. 3151

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO COMPENSATION FOR CITY EMPLOYEES; AMENDING SECTION 2.48.185 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, SUMMARY PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood has authority to create and delete employee positions in the City, and to establish and amend pay grade classifications and compensation amounts for employee positions in the City; and

WHEREAS, in LMC 2.48.175, the City Council has established a basic pay plan for certain City employees based on pay grade classifications; and

WHEREAS, in LMC 2.48.185, the City Council established pay grade classifications for certain employee positions in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is appropriate and in the best interests of the City to amend LMC 2.48.185 add the following classifications in the Community Development Department: Planning Manager at Pay Grade 623 and Permit Center Supervisor at Pay Grade 619 now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.48.185 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

2.48.185 Pay grade classification.

The following shall be the pay grades in the basic pay plan set forth in LMC 2.48.175, assigned to the appropriate position:




