ORDINANCE NO. 3159

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR JUSTICE CENTER IMPROVEMENTS RELATED TO THE AUTOMATIC POWER TRANSFER SWITCH; AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES IN REET FUND 331; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the Justice Center is currently equipped with an automatic power transfer switch which switches the facilities power source to an 80 kW emergency generator during power outages; and

WHEREAS, the automatic power transfer switch and the 80 kW emergency generator do not provide adequate power to power the entire building during power outages; and

WHEREAS, starting in 2010 and sometime thereafter, the Justice Center was equipped with a 350 kW emergency generator and a manual power transfer switch which provides adequate power for the entire facility; and

WHEREAS, the city now desires to replace the 350 kW emergency generator manual power transfer switch with an automatic power transfer switch and decommission the 80 kW emergency generator and associated connection; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated funding for the Project will be from REET fund 331, of which the proposed improvements to be completed by the Project are eligible expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Appropriation:

A. The estimated costs of the project are provided in detail on the attached Financial Plan dated 10/09/2015, and summarized as follows:






