**ORDINANCE NO. 3170**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, SUPERSADING ORDINANCE #3137 AND ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE CITYWIDE SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT. THIS ORDINANCE AUTHORIZES PROJECT EXPENDITURES IN FUND 356; AND FUNDING ALLOCATIONS/TRANSFER FROM FUND 331 TO FUND 356; AND RECEIPT DISTRIBUTIONS AND REIMBURSEMENTS FROM CITYWIDE SAFETY GRANT TO FUNDS 356; CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.**

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement program as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Citywide Safety Improvement Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's 6-Year Transportation Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Project will provide various safety improvements throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained \$300,000 of Washington State Department of Transportation City Safety Program grant for the Project;

WHEREAS, the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3015;

WHEREAS, the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3137;

WHEREAS, the design phase has been completed for the Project and the City now desires to have the project constructed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Appropriation:**




