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16           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to  
17 appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations  
18 from one fund to another fund; and

19           **WHEREAS**, the City of Lynnwood is committed to the maintenance and repair of the  
20 City of Lynnwood's Street, Storm Drainage, Water, and Sanitary Sewer system in an ongoing  
21 and proactive basis; and

22           **WHEREAS**, the Lynnwood Operations and Maintenance Center (LOMC) has  
23 immediate need for dry, heated storage for weather sensitive equipment; and

24           **WHEREAS**, the Service and Maintenance Agreement with Fire District One for  
25 maintenance of fire vehicles and aid cars at the LOMC provides the funding for this new  
26 structure; and

27           **WHEREAS**, the project was advertised for competitive bids, with the lowest  
28 responsible bidder being Spane Buildings, Inc.; and

29           **WHEREAS**, the City of Lynnwood has the Lynnwood Operations and Maintenance  
30 Center, (LOMC), Fund 513, to address ongoing Center maintenance and improvements;

31           **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON,**  
32           **DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**  
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34 Section 1. Appropriation:

35 A. The estimated costs of the project are provided in detail on the attached Financial Plan  
 36 dated February 19, 2016, and summarized as follows:

 44 carried forward from year to year until fully expended or the purpose has been  
 45 accomplished or abandoned without necessity of re-appropriation.

46 Section 2. Modification of the (2015-2016) Biennial Budget. The required expenditures for  
 47 the operation of the various departments and funds of the City of Lynnwood for fiscal years  
 48 ending December 31, (2015 and 2016), and hereby modified and amended, attached  
 49 hereto and incorporated within.

50 Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this  
 51 ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent  
 52 jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality therefore, shall not affect the validity or  
 53 constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this  
 54 ordinance.

55 Section 4. Effective Date This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall  
56 be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force  
57 five (5) days after publication.
