16       **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to  
17 appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations  
18 from one fund to another fund; and

19       **WHEREAS**, the City is committed to a planned transportation, traffic, utilities, and  
20 public facilities preservation and improvement programs as a part of the City  
21 Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

22       **WHEREAS**, the City has completed or is close to completing the design phase of  
23 eight (8) different capital projects that are planned to be constructed in 2016; and

24       **WHEREAS**, these eight (8) capital projects are individually part of the transportation,  
25 traffic, utility, or public facilities preservation and improvement programs with various  
26 sources of funding including local and Federal funds; and

27       **WHEREAS**, in summer of 2015, the City solicited for statement of qualifications from  
28 consulting firms with expertise, resources, and capabilities in capital construction  
29 management of non-Federal and Federal funded capital projects; and

30       **WHEREAS**, the City went through the scoring and interviewing processes and has  
31 selected two (2) consulting firms that are the most qualified to provide construction  
32 services for all the capital construction projects in 2016; and

33       **WHEREAS**, one of the eight (8) projects, the Citywide Safety Improvement project,  
34 has approval from Council by way of Ordinance #3170 passed on 12/14/2015, to include an  
35 estimated amount of \$120,000 for construction management services in the financial plan;

1           **WHEREAS**, on 02/08/2016, City Council authorized the Mayor to enter into, and  
 2 execute on behalf of the City a contract with AECOM for the construction support services  
 3 in the amount not to exceed \$120,000;

4           **WHEREAS**, the amount of \$120,000 will be referred to but not included in the total  
 5 requested amount for the 2016 Capital Construction Management Services;

6           **WHEREAS**, consultant services for construction management may include, but not  
 7 be limited to, resident engineering, contract administration, office and field support  
 8 services, inspection, and surveying and testing and/or managing the work of surveying and  
 9 testing firms during construction, and managing sub-consultants as appropriate, as well as  
 10 all other related tasks; and

11           **WHEREAS**, the City will re-evaluate internal staff resources at the time each task  
 12 order and/or project approaches construction readiness and determine the best method to  
 13 accomplish the work which may include City staff resources only, consultant services only,  
 14 and/or combinations; and

 16           **NOW THEREFORE**, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON,  
 17 DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

18    **Section 1. Appropriation:**


