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18 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to
19 appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations
20 from one fund to another fund; and

21 **WHEREAS,** the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic
22 improvement program as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities
23 Plan; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the Citywide Safety Improvement Project (hereinafter "Project") is
25 included in the City's 6-Year Transportation Improvement Plan; and

26 **WHEREAS,** the Project will provide various safety improvements throughout the
27 City; and

28 **WHEREAS,** the City has obtained \$931,000 of Washington State Department of
29 Transportation City Safety Program grant for the Project;

30 **WHEARAS,** the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3016;

31 **WHEREAS,** the design phase has been completed for the Project and the City now
32 desires to have the project constructed.

33 **WHEREAS,** the construction management support funding for this project will be
34 covered under a separate ordinance and financial plan;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON,
 2 DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:




