ORDINANCE NO. 3184

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION FOR MEADOWDALE NEIGHBORHOOD PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT. THIS ORDINANCE AUTHORIZES PROJECT EXPENDITURES IN FUND 322; AND FUNDING ALLOCATIONS/TRANSFERS FROM FUND 330 TO FUND 322; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to addressing deficiencies and community needs in the park system as part of the PARC Comprehensive Plan and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Meadowdale Neighborhood Park Improvement Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities plan as project number PK2003048A; and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan identifies the need to increase parking access at most area parks including the Project site and this Project will more than double the available parking from 9 stalls to approximately 24 total parking stalls; and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan identifies the need for additional picnic shelters with barbeques in the park systems which are reservable; and

WHEREAS, the City has selected Bush, Roed & Hichings (BRH) firm to complete design and engineering for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to initiate and complete construction of the Project parking lot and picnic shelter within one year; now, therefore

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1: Appropriation**


1 **Section 2: Modification of the Budget.** The required expenditures for operation of the
