ORDINANCE NO. 3187

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE #3092 UPDATING THE FINANCIAL FOR THE INTERURBAN TRAIL SOUTH SEGMENT MISSING LINK PROJECT (212TH STREET SW AT 63RD AVENUE W). THIS ORDINANCE AUTHORIZES PROJECT EXPENDITURES IN FUND 350; AND FUNDING ALLOCATIONS/ TRANSFERS FROM FUND 331 TO FUND 350; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement program as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Interurban Trail South Missing Link Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities plan as project number 200900142; and

WHEREAS, in 2010 the City sold utility bonds for various projects, one of which is the Project; and

WHEREAS, project utility retrofits deem this project eligible for Utility Bond funding; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained Federal Enhancement and Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality, (CMAQ) Grants for the Project;

WHEREAS, the City plans to spend the appropriations for the Project over the next two years; and

WHEREAS, the Project will improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety by providing a new and continuous trail corridor separated from traffic adjacent to where the existing trail occurs; and

WHEREAS, the Project was suspended, and the existing circuitous alignment abandoned in favor of a more direct route through the historic Interurban corridor which is currently

1 occupied by the Snohomish County PUD. The PUD is expected make available this alignment in
 2 late 2015, allowing for construction of the trail; and

3 WHEREAS, the City will supplement the design phase of the design contract #1918 with
 4 SvR Design Company in the amount of \$83,600 which will address a substantial change from the
 5 50% plan review, the City will allocated \$10,000 of the CMAQ grant to WSDOT for review in
 6 accordance with the LA Agreement; and

7 WHEREAS, the City will enter into a contract with Roland Resources for Right-of-Way
 8 phase work in the amount of \$38,500 to cover services for acquiring necessary property rights
 9 for construction; and

10 WHEREAS, additional local funds in the amount of \$126,300 will be transferred from
 11 fund 331 to fund 350 as detailed in the financial plan dated 03/04/2016; now, therefore
