ORDINANCE NO. 3188

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE 2016 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT – SYSTEM RATINGS PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING PROJECT EXPENDITURES IN FUND 311; AND FUNDING ALLOCATIONS AND TRANSFERS FROM FUND 331 TO FUND 311; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation, traffic, utilities, and public facilities preservation and improvement programs as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has inventoried approximately 103 centerline miles of City streets including principal arterials, collector arterials, minor arterials, and residential streets that need to be maintained; and

WHEREAS, due to budget limitation for pavement preservation, the City has identified the need to prioritize paving projects based on surface conditions to use limited dollars to preserve and improve the City's transportation assets in the most efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, under Chapter 39.34 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is allowed to make purchases using another agency's purchasing contract, a process known as "piggybacking"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood used the City of Tacoma's contract with Infrastructure Management Services (IMS), to procure IMS' service to deliver the 2016 Pavement Management – System Ratings project; and

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
