ORDINANCE NO. 3191

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE 3093; AND ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE 2015/2016 ROAD OVERLAY & REBUILD PROGRAM ON 184TH STREET SW BETWEEN ALDERWOOD MALL PARKWAY AND 33RD AVENUE W, AND ALDERWOOD MALL PARKWAY BETWEEN ASH WAY AND 184TH STREET SW; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation, traffic, utilities, and public facilities preservation and improvement programs as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood is prepared to proceed with an improvement project included in the capital facilities Plan as project number ST1997031A; and

WHEREAS, the 2015/2016 Road overlay and rebuild program will provide improved roadway safety and longevity on 184th Street SW and Alderwood Mall Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3093; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained \$800,000 of Snohomish County STP grant for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the design phase has been completed for the Project and the City now desires to have the project constructed; and

WHEREAS, the City previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3181 to provide the construction management support funding for this project; and

1 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS
 2 FOLLOWS:

3 Section 1. Appropriation:

4 A. The City Council hereby authorizes project expenditures in Fund 311; and funding
 5 allocations/transfers from Fund 331 and Fund 150 to Fund 311. The City shall receive and make
 6 distributions and reimbursements from STP Grant to Fund 311. Such funding transactions shall
 7 be consistent with the project financial plan attached hereto. The estimated costs of the
 8 project are provided in detail on the attached Financial Plan dated April 13, 2016 and
 9 summarized as follows:



