ORDINANCE NO. 3195

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO CLASSIFICATION FOR CITY EMPLOYEES; AMENDING SECTION 2.48.185 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood has authority to create and delete employee positions in the City, and to establish and amend pay grade classifications and compensation amounts for employee positions in the City; and

WHEREAS, in LMC 2.48.175, the City Council has established a basic pay plan for certain City employees based on pay grade classifications; and

WHEREAS, in LMC 2.48.185, the City Council established pay grade classifications for certain employee positions in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is appropriate, and in the best interests of the City, to amend LMC 2.48.185 to add the position of Fire Administrative Supervisor for the Fire Department and place the position at Pay Grade 621, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.48.185 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

2.48.185 Pay grade classification.

The following shall be the pay grades in the basic pay plan set forth in LMC 2.48.175, assigned to the appropriate position:

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.




