13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to
14 appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations
15 from one fund to another fund; and

16 WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement
17 program as a part of the City's Transportation Improvement Program and Capital Facilities Plan;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the Bike2Health Improvement Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in
20 the City's Capital Facilities Plan as project number 201400164; and

21 WHEREAS, the Project will serve to improve access to safer cycling by all community
22 residents, increase ridership, and generally improve the health of community members upon
23 completion of the regional bicycle network.; and

24 WHEREAS, in the year 2014, the Cities of Lynnwood, Edmonds and Mountlake Terrace
25 were jointly awarded \$1,900,000 in grant funds from the Verdant Health Commission to
26 complete the Project; and

27 WHEREAS, the City has previously approved a Project financial plan in Ordinance 3123;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN
