**ORDINANCE NO. 3199**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION FOR INTERURBAN TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT – PHASE 1: 44<sup>TH</sup> AVE TRAIL HEAD. THIS ORDINANCE AUTHORIZES PROJECT EXPENDITURES IN FUND 322; AND FUNDING ALLOCATIONS/TRANSFERS FROM FUND 330 TO FUND 322; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to addressing deficiencies and community needs in the park system as part of the PARC Comprehensive Plan and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Interurban Trail Improvement Project (hereinafter “Project”) is included in the City’s Capital Facilities plan as project number PK1998021A; and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan identifies the need to improve connectivity through the development of shared-use trails which serve to connect parks, neighborhoods, and public amenities (Policy 12.1); and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan recommends master planning and implementing Interurban Trail corridor upgrades and improvements and support interjurisdictional efforts to provide consistent and aesthetic improvements along the length of the trail (Action 5.12.4); and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan recommends utilizing capital investments in parks, trails, open spaces, recreation and art to encourage and support economic development and revitalization (Action 3.9.4); and

WHEREAS, City staff assisted by HBB Landscape Architects have met with community stakeholders to gather feedback on the Master Plan for Interurban Trail Improvements and will complete the Master Plan in June 2016; and

1 WHEREAS, the Interurban Trail Master Plan will outline recommendations for new  
 2 amenities (e.g. benches, drinking fountains), interpretive signage, public art, and community  
 3 activation unique to four trail segments; and

4 WHEREAS, the City has received a \$5,000 grant from the Lynnwood Parks & Recreation  
 5 Foundation and \$7,938 from the Snohomish County Small Capital Projects Partnership Program  
 6 for trail head improvements at 40<sup>th</sup> Ave W / Alderwood Mall Boulevard; and

7 WHEREAS, the City plans to initiate and complete construction of the Project trail head  
 8 improvements at 40<sup>th</sup> Ave W within the one year; now, therefore
