14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to
15 appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations
16 from one fund to another fund; and

17 WHEREAS, the Justice Center is currently equipped with an automatic transfer switch
18 which transfers the facility's power source to an 80 kW emergency generator during power
19 outages; and

20 WHEREAS, the automatic power transfer switch and the 80 kW emergency generator do
21 not provide adequate power to the entire building during power outages; and

22 WHEREAS, starting in 2010 and sometime thereafter, the Justice Center was equipped
23 with a 350 kW emergency generator and a manual power transfer switch which provides
24 adequate power for the entire facility; and

25 WHEREAS, the City now desires to replace the manual transfer switch for the 350kW
26 generator with an automatic transfer switch and decommission the 80 kW emergency
27 generator and associated appurtenances, and;

28 WHEREAS, the anticipated funding for the project will be from REET Fund 331, of which
29 the proposed improvements to be completed by the project are eligible expenses; and

30 WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood has previously approved a financial plan in Ordinance
31 3159;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO
33 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1. Appropriation:**

A. The estimated costs of the project are provided in detail on the attached Financial Plan dated 6/6/2016, and summarized as follows:


