**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON,  
ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE 2015-2016 BIENNIAL BUDGET;  
PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL OF THE AMENDED BUDGET TO  
THE STATE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.**

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2014, by Ordinance No. 3091, the City Council adopted a biennial budget for the years 2015-2016; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3111, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget relating to the Economic Development Infrastructure Fund (Fund 020); and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3115, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget relating to the purchase of real property; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3116, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget relating to the purchase of real property; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3120, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget relating to the Information Services Department; and

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3135, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget relating to the carryover of certain funds from the 2013-2014 biennial budget; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3139, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget relating to Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP); and

WHEREAS, on November 23, 2015, by Ordinance No. 3163, the City Council adopted mid-biennial amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2016, by Ordinance No. 3203, the City Council adopted amendments to the 2015-16 biennial budget; and

1 WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully considered the proposed budget amendments  
2 and finds that amendments authorized by this Ordinance are consistent with applicable laws  
3 and financial policies, and further the public's health, safety and welfare, now therefore:

4 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS  
5 FOLLOWS:

6 Section 1. Amendment of the 2015-2016 Biennial Budget. Revenues and expenditures for  
7 operation of Fire department of the City of Lynnwood for the fiscal years ending December 31,  
8 2015 and 2016, are hereby modified and amended as shown in **Exhibit A** attached hereto and  
9 incorporated herein.

10 Section 2. Transmittal. A complete copy of this ordinance shall be transmitted to the  
11 Washington State Auditor's Office and to the Association of Washington Cities.

12 Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be  
13 held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or  
14 unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section,  
15 sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

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17 Section 4. Effective Date and Summary Publication. This ordinance or a summary thereof  
18 consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take  
19 effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
