ORDINANCE NO. 3215

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING PROJECT FUNDING FOR CONSTRUCTION FOR THE LYNNDALE PARK OFF-LEASH DOG AREA. THIS ORDINANCE AUTHORIZES PROJECT EXPENDITURES IN FUND 322; AND FUNDING ALLOCATIONS/TRANSFERS FROM FUND 331 TO FUND 322; AND CONSISTENT WITH THE PROJECT FINANCIAL PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.33 RCW, the City of Lynnwood is required to appropriate funds for City projects and to formally authorize the transfer of appropriations from one fund to another fund; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to addressing deficiencies and community needs in the park system as part of the PARC Comprehensive Plan and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Lynndale Park Off-Leash Dog Area Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities plan as project number 200400115; and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan identifies the need to add off-leash dog areas and dog park amenities into the park system in response to identified community need (Policy 4.1); and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan identifies the development of an off-leash dog area at Lynndale Park (Action 2.4.9); and

WHEREAS, the PARC Plan recommends identifying opportunities to create public gathering spaces that enable residents of all ages to connect with each other (Policy 1.6); and

WHEREAS, City staff held a community open house meeting at Lynndale Park on Saturday, June 25, 2016 to gather feedback about potential impacts of the selected .6-acre location and what types of amenities are desired by dog owners; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to initiate and complete construction of the Project within six months on the northwest corner of Lynndale Park along Olympic View Drive utilizing a storm vault surface and parking lot; now, therefore

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
1 Section 2: Modification of the Budget. The required expenditures for operation of the various

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
