RESOLUTION NO. 2011-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURSUE AND EXECUTE APPLICATION AND ALL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2012 SNOHOMISH COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANTS.

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Human Services Department Office of Housing and Community Development (OHCD) has announced a call for projects for its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program for the 2012 funding year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood desires to improve and enhance the pedestrian facilities along 204th Street SW between 68th Avenue W and Highway 99; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood is eligible to apply for CDBG funding for said improvements; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of any grants for said improvements would be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Lynnwood;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Declaration of Need; Authorization. The City Council of the City of Lynnwood declares that it supports pursuing grant applications for pedestrian facilities along 204th Street SW and authorizes the Mayor of the City of Lynnwood to pursue and execute application and all contractual agreements or other documents necessary to obtain the approval of any CDBG grants to analyze, design, and construct such improvements.

Section 2. This Resolution shall form part of a formal application to the OHCD.


1 Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after
