



RESOLUTION NO. 2013-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON
REGARDING FURTHER PARTICIPATION IN THE REGIONAL FIRE
PROTECTION SERVICE AUTHORITY PLANNING COMMITTEE.**

WHEREAS RCW 52.26 provides that two or more adjacent fire protection jurisdictions may create the Regional Fire Protection Service Authority (RFPSA) and convene an RFPSA planning committee; and

WHEREAS the cities of Mukilteo, Edmonds, Mountlake Terrace, Lynnwood, Brier, and Woodway, together with Snohomish County fire protection District number one and District 7 are all adjacent fire protection jurisdictions that formed a regional fire protection service planning committee.

WHEREAS the City Council has reviewed the information presented by its Regional Fire Authority (RFA) representatives and staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the city of Lynnwood as follows:

1. The city of Lynnwood hereby withdraws as an active voting participant of the planning committee, and hereby gives notice to the planning committee.
2. City of Lynnwood continues to have a substantial and continuing interest in a regional fire service.
3. City of Lynnwood plans to continue attending meetings of the planning committee and will continue to evaluate future involvement of the city in a regional fire service agency.
4. Should the RFA election be successful, the City of Lynnwood fire service will continue its close cooperation and coordination with its neighboring jurisdictions, whether within or out of the RFA, to provide quality fire protection, rescue and emergency medical services to the citizens of our region.


