



**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-04**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE  
VARIOUS RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION DOCUMENTS NECESSARY  
FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE 204<sup>TH</sup> STREET SW IMPROVEMENT  
PROJECT (SR-99 TO 68<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE W).**

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WHEREAS, the City is committed to a planned transportation and traffic improvement program as a part of the City Transportation Program and Capital Facilities Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 204<sup>TH</sup> Street SW Improvements Project (hereinafter "Project") is included in the City's Capital Facilities plan as project number ST2002043A; and

WHEREAS, the Project will improve vehicle, pedestrian and bicyclist access and safety by providing a new continuous 3-lane roadway with concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, and bike lanes along the both sides of 204<sup>th</sup> St. SW from SR-99 to 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue W. The project will also feature a roundabout at the intersection with 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue W, and a traffic signal at SR-99; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2784 previously authorized funding for the Project in Fund 318; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that the Project is in the best interests of the public health, safety and general welfare, and that the Mayor should be authorized to execute the documents necessary for the acquisition of the easements and right-of-way interests necessary for the Project; now, therefore

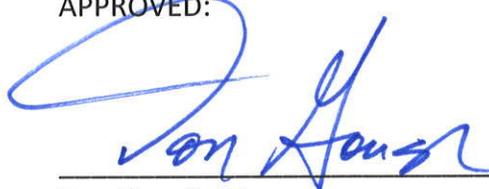
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS  
FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Lynnwood hereby authorizes the Mayor and his authorized designees to pursue, sign and execute all documentation related to the City's acquisition of any easements and right of way interests necessary for the completion of the 204<sup>th</sup> Street SW Improvement Project in accordance with administrative settlement authority to pay amounts (1) up to the appraised value of the property interests being acquired plus 20 percent, or \$2,500, whichever is larger, and (2) that are within the funding available within the financial plan previously approved and adopted by the City Council for the Project.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval.

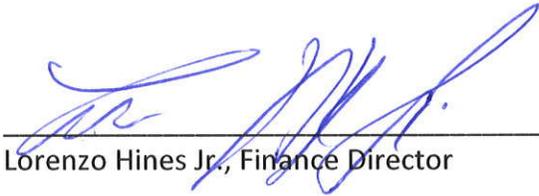
