



**RESOLUTION NO. 2014 – 09**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LYNNWOOD FIRE DEPARTMENT'S "2014 STANDARDS OF COVER" – DESCRIBING THE COMMUNITY'S FIRE AND NON-FIRE RISK FACTORS, TYPES OR SERVICES PROVIDED, DEPLOYMENT OR RESOURCES, AND RESPONSE PERFORMANCE STANDARDS AND GOALS.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Lynnwood Fire Department is legally established as a fire department through Lynnwood Municipal Ordinance 353, to provide certain emergency medical, fire and rescue services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lynnwood Fire Department has a mission statement and established procedures to guide the organization in providing fire and medical services to our community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lynnwood Fire Department is required by statute to establish turnout and travel time goals for the first arriving Basic Life Support Unit, Advanced Life Support Unit and Fire Engine, and a travel time goal for a 1<sup>st</sup> Alarm assignment to a structure fire; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lynnwood Fire Department continually evaluates and adopts best practices to improved it response time performance;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council, of the City of Lynnwood hereby adopts the below 2014 Standards of Coverage as the Lynnwood Fire Department's official standards for determining emergency medical fire and rescue repose standards and goals as provided in RCW 35.103.




