**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF LYNNWOOD WASHINGTON,
ADOPTING THE CITY OF DAMYANG, IN THE JEOLLANAM-DO PROVINCE OF
KOREA, AS A SISTER CITY OF LYNNWOOD**

WHEREAS, the Sister City Program speaks directly to the City of Lynnwood's overall community vision, specifically to invest in preserving and expanding parks, recreation, and community programs and to be a cohesive community that respects all citizens; and

WHEREAS, the people of Lynnwood have demonstrated a desire to learn more about the people of other communities throughout the world and enhance international communication and understanding, and want to encourage educational, cultural, athletic, trade, tourism, business, technology, and governmental exchanges to help acquaint themselves with the diverse peoples of the world; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood wants to provide its people with opportunities that offer services and gain benefits from community projects of international scope; and

WHEREAS, leaders and members of the Lynnwood Korean community have expressed strong support and interest, and are committed to the success and sustainability of Damyang as the Sister City to Lynnwood;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Lynnwood hereby adopts the city of Damyang, Korea, as its Sister City, and a copy of this resolution is to be sent to the Office of the Mayor of Damyang in Korea, the Consulate General of the Republic of Korea, and the Lieutenant Governor of Washington.


