COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

In accordance with RCW Chapter 39.34 and to other provisions of the law, The City of Seattle ("City") and the City of Lynnwood ("Lynnwood") hereby agree to a cooperative governmental purchasing agreement for various supplies, materials, equipment and services, using the City's competitively awarded contracts. The following terms and conditions apply:

1. The City, in contracting for the purchase of supplies, materials, equipment and services for the City, agrees, at its discretion, to extend said contracts to Lynnwood to the extent permitted by law, and agreed upon by the Lynnwood and the vendor(s).
2. Lynnwood shall be responsible for compliance with any additional or varying laws and regulations governing purchases by or on behalf of Lynnwood.
3. Any purchases by Lynnwood shall be effected by a purchase order from Lynnwood and directed to the vendor(s).
4. The City shall not accept responsibility for the performance of any vendor contracted for by Lynnwood as a result of this Agreement.
5. The City shall not be responsible for the payment of any item(s) contracted for by Lynnwood as a result of this Agreement.
6. This Agreement shall continue in force until canceled in writing by either party.
