

Citywide Channelized Stream Maintenance Program
(File No. ERC-003878-2016)

Application and Project Description

On May 9, 2016, Jared Bond (City of Lynnwood Environmental Supervisor) submitted an application on behalf of the applicant, the City of Lynnwood, for environmental review for the five year Citywide Channelized Stream Maintenance Program (2016-2021), which addresses maintenance to restore channelized streams within the Lynnwood Right-of-Ways, or other Lynnwood owned/controlled areas, to previously existing form, function and flow. This work may include bank stabilization and repair, Large Woody Material (LWM) repositioning, and sediment, small woody material, or debris removal. Work may occur within culverted/piped segments of streams. Maintenance will take place between July 16 and September 15, annually. Specific information regarding improvements is available by contacting City staff. The application was deemed complete on May 12, 2016.

The project is City-wide

SEPA Environmental Review:

The City has reviewed the proposed project for probable adverse environmental impacts and expects to issue a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for this project.
