NOTICE OF FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION
CITY-WIDE CHANNELIZED STREAM MAINTENANCE PROGRAM
Mitigated Determination of Non-Significance
(ERC-03878-2016)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Lynnwood has issued a Mitigated Determination of Non-significance (MDNS) for the following proposal:

APPLICANT:

PROPOSAL Adoption of the five year Citywide Channelized Stream Maintenance Program (2016-2021), which addresses maintenance to restore channelized streams within the Lynnwood Right-of-Ways, or other Lynnwood owned/controlled areas, to previously existing form, function and flow. This work may include bank stabilization and repair, Large Woody Material (LWM) repositioning, and sediment, small woody material, or debris removal. Work may occur within culverted/piped segments of streams. Maintenance will take place between July 16 and September 15, annually.

LOCATION: City-wide

MITIGATION:

ADVERSE IMPACT - Impact on habitat caused by activities. **MITIGATION MEASURE- A.** Coordination with local, state and federal agencies with applicable approvals to be received prior to construction.

ADVERSE IMPACT - Protection of fishery habitat during spawning season. **MITIGATION MEASURE-** Activities to take place in streams and adjacent habitat outside of the time period of the year when fish are spawning or when eggs in beds may be exposed.

Comments and Appeals: This MDNS is issued under WAC 197-11-350; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 15 days from date of issue. Comments must be submitted by **Friday, July 1, 2016**. This MDNS becomes final at 4:00 PM on Friday, July 15, 2016, unless the determination is withdrawn or amended by the City's SEPA Responsible Official.

You may appeal this determination by submitting an appeal to the Community Development Department at 4114 198th St SW, Suite 7, PO Box 5008, Lynnwood, WA 98046. An appeal may be submitted only after the close of the comment period but no later than 4:00 PM on **Friday, July 15, 2016** which is 14 days from the end of the comment period. Be prepared to make specific factual objections. The fee for an appeal is as set forth in LMC 3.104.
