NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Lynnwood SEPA Responsible Official has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for the following proposal.

Project Description:

This proposal is for a non-project action for text amendments to the Lynnwood Municipal Code (LMC) to adopt new regulations with regards to the discharge of mercury and other contaminants into the City of Lynnwood's Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW). Chapter 14.60 is amended to limit the amount of concentration of mercury and other harmful contaminants. Chapter 14.06 definitions are also being amended.

Location: N/A – not site specific

Comments and Appeals:

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340 (2)(c); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 15 days from the date of issue. Comments must be submitted by July 22, 2016. This DNS becomes final at **4:00 PM on July 22, 2016**, unless the determination is withdrawn or amended by the City's SEPA Responsible Official.

You may appeal this determination by submitting an appeal to the Community Development Department at 4114 198th St SW, Suite 7, PO Box 5008, Lynnwood, WA 98046. An appeal may be submitted only after the close of the comment period but no later than **4:00 PM on August 5, 2016**, which is 14 days from the end of the comment period. Be prepared to make specific factual objections. The fee for an appeal is as set forth in LMC 3.104.
