## DECLARATION OF NON-RESPONSIBILITY

### Traffic Camera Red Light Enforcement Program

A DECLARATION OF NON-RESPONSIBILITY may not be used by employers/principals to transfer responsibility to their employees/agents. As a matter of law, a vehicle registered to an employer/principal that is driven by an employee/agent remains in the "care, custody, and control" of the employer/agent and thus, the employer/principal is responsible for payment of the infraction penalty. Like a parking infraction, an employee/agent may take responsibility for a traffic camera infraction by submitting payment directly to the Court or by requesting a hearing in his or her name. Infractions generated by traffic cameras will not appear on any Department of Licensing driver record.

In the space above, you must accurately write the 13-digit Notice Number that appears in the box in the upper right of the front of your Notice of Infraction. Also please provide the license plate number and state for the vehicle involved in the infraction. Please write clearly and make sure you record the information accurately. If the Notice of Infraction Number is unclear or incorrect, the Court will not be able to match your declaration to your infraction, and the Notice of Infraction will proceed to a collection agency if not paid.

The registered owner of a vehicle is presumed to have operated the vehicle at the time an infraction was detected by an automated traffic safety camera unless the registered owner overcomes the presumption by a statement, under oath, in writing to the court or in testimony before the court that the vehicle involved was, at the time, stolen or in the care, custody, or control of some person other than the registered owner.

If your vehicle was stolen, sold, prior to the date and time of the violation or in the care, custody or control of someone else at the time of the violation, please fill out a Declaration of Non-Responsibility below.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the information provided in this declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I received the Notice of Infraction; the number is listed on the reverse side of this Declaration. At the time of the occurrence of the violation indicated in the Notice of Infraction, the vehicle described was:

- Stolen and a copy of the police report is enclosed
