Grow an edible plant in your yard or a pot	Plan your meals for a week	Replace single use batteries with rechargeables in one item	Go outside and count how many birds you see	Shorten your shower (goal = 5 min or less)
Unplug unused electronics / chargers	Put all your food scraps in your food and yard waste bin	Eat a plant-based (no meat or dairy) dinner	Bike or walk instead of driving on one trip	Plant a native plant or remove an invasive plant like blackberry, English ivy, and scotch broom
Lower your thermostat to 68 during the day and 61 overnight	Don't buy or drink bottled water all month	 FREE SPACE	Install a rain barrel	Avoid the use of pesticides, herbicides and synthetic fertilizers
Wash your car in the yard instead of the driveway	Hang up a bird feeder	Fix leaky faucets	Commit to carrying reusable bags	Pick up litter
