- F. Wong reported on the following:
  - EGGs-plore Lynnwood netted \$1,110 with the auction of ten (10) eggs.

  - Almost all the festivals, public events, etc. has been cancelled through September 2020 due to the COVID-19.

- South Lynnwood Park was going to have a big renovation starting early summer. Because of COVID delays, we just now finally have the OK from the National Park Service to proceed but is three (3) months behind. The search for a contractor is now underway to start work (hopefully) in mid-September. Mural for that park may be painted ahead of the renovation.

### 80.1 Trolley - name

Lynnwood City Council has approved the petition to have Walter V. Shannon's (the last Interurban motorman) name to be added to the Interurban Trolley 55 at Heritage Park.

### 80.2 LOVE Lynnwood Iconic Sculpture

F. Wong reported that in April 2020, he was supposed to present to the Lynnwood PFD on how to build the sculpture but due to COVID-19, could not present until July 7, 2020 and met on-line. PFD gave its approval. This project is still moving along.

- Native American box has received a grant and can now proceed. F. Wong will work with an artist for a draft.
