

CITY OF LYNNWOOD SALARY COMMISSION

ON SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS SALARY SCHEDULE FOR 2021 & 2022, the City of Lynnwood Salary Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials pursuant to (Ord. 3348 § 1, 2019) of the City of Lynnwood hereby adopts the following salary schedule for elected officials:

1. Mayor: The Mayor's salary for 2021 is \$10,342 per month through December 31, 2021.

Effective January 1, 2022, the Mayor's salary for 2022 will be the Mayor's base wage in effect on December 31, 2021, increased by the percent change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) (1982-84 = 100) for the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue area for the June 2020 to June 2021 index. If the CPI-U is greater than 2.5%, the percentage increase shall be capped at 2.5%.

If the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) (1982-84 = 100) for the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue area for the June to June index is zero percent (0%) or below, the Mayor's salary for the respective year shall remain the same as the Mayor's previous year's salary.

2. City Council Members: The City Council Members' salary for 2021 shall be \$1,650.00 per month through December 31, 2021. Upon subsequent election the salary shall be \$1,310.50 per month.

The salary for the City Council member designated as the City Council President shall remain an additional \$200 per month or 2,400 per year in addition to the base salary.

Effective January 1, 2022, the City Council members' salary for 2022 will be the Council members' base wage in effect on December 31, 2021, increased by the percent change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) (1982-84 = 100) for the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue area for the June 2020 to June 2021 index. If the CPI-U is greater than 2.5%, the percentage increase shall be capped at 2.5%.

If the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) (1982-84 = 100) for the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue area for the June to June index is zero percent (0%) or below, the City Council members' salary for the respective year shall remain the same as the Council members' previous year's salary.

3. Benefits: All benefits for the Mayor, City Council Members, and Municipal Court Judges are provided by the city, and are outside the scope of this schedule.

Additional comments for consideration:


1. Consider repeal of LMC 2.04.074 Council member waiver and election not to receive “per meeting” pay compensation as the “per meeting” compensation has now been rolled into one salary.
2. The City of Lynnwood should maintain a separate unique classification for Council Members that differentiates them from other City employees LMC 2.04.073
3. Recommend that the Lynnwood Salary Commission be allowed to make binding salary and benefits recommendations for the city’s elected officials, specifically City Council and Mayor, as other Salary Commissions currently do.


