3 **SUBMITTAL OF SEALED BIDS:**

4 Sealed bid proposals ("Bids") will be received by the Public Works Director, or the Public Works
5 Director's representative, at Lynnwood City Hall, 19100 44th Avenue W., Lynnwood, Snohomish
6 County, Washington, 98036 (or mailed to P.O. Box 5008, Lynnwood, WA 98046-5008), until 2:00
7 p.m., October 30, 2018, for the following project ("Project"):

8 **Sewer Force Main #8, Project #3**

9 Capitalized terms not defined in this Invitation for Bids shall have the meanings set forth in the
10 Project Manual of which this Invitation for Bids is a part.

11 **BID OPENING:**

12 At the time and date above stated, the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud ("Bid
13 Opening"). Bids are to be submitted only on the bid proposal forms provided with the Project
14 Manual. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid bond, cashier's check, certified check, or postal
15 money order in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Bid. Bids
16 received after the time fixed for the Bid Opening will not be considered.

17 **DESCRIPTION OF WORK:**

18 The project generally consists of installing a 14-inch ductile iron force main by trenching
19 installation along Alderwood Mall Boulevard from existing Lift Station 8 southeast along
20 Alderwood Mall Blvd to 195th Place SW, south on 36th Avenue West and west on 196th St SW
21 to 40th Ave West. Directional drilling an 18-inch HDPE segment of the force main will be
22 required to connect the force main between 195th Place SW and Alderwood Mall Boulevard.
23 Casing will be required for pipe within the WSDOT limited access right-of-way on 196th St SW
24 and on a portion of 36th Ave West.

25 All Bids shall be based upon compliance with the Project Manual (including, without limitation,
26 the Contract Plans and Specifications). The estimated cost range for this project is \$2,500,000 to
27 \$3,250,000. The project shall be Physically Completed within 130 working days of the Notice to
28 Proceed.

29 **OBTAINING BID DOCUMENTS:**

30 The Project Manual for this Project (including the Contract Plans, Specifications and all other
31 Contract Documents) may be examined at the Lynnwood City Hall. All questions regarding to

14 Bidder Proposals shall remain valid for forty-five (45) days after the actual date of Bid Opening.

16 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of

19 notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this
