**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan,
(ERC-009836-2021)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Lynnwood SEPA Responsible Official has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for the following proposal.

Project Description:

On June 28, 2021, Amie Hanson, Public Works Project Manager with the City of Lynnwood, submitted an application for a SEPA threshold determination for the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan. This is a non-project action for the plan that will implement continuous improvements of City programs and facilities for people with disabilities. The ADA self-evaluation identifies and makes recommendations to correct policies and practices in the City's programs and services that serve as barriers to people with disabilities and are inconsistent with title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Location: Citywide

Comments and Appeals:

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340 (2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issue. Comments must be submitted by **October 8, 2021**. This DNS becomes at close of business on October 8, 2021, unless the determination is withdrawn or amended by the City's SEPA Responsible Official.

You may appeal this determination by submitting an appeal to the Community Development Department at 20816 44th Ave W, Suite 230, Lynnwood, WA 98036. An appeal may be submitted only after the close of the comment period but no later than **October 22, 2021**, which is 14 days from the end of the comment period. Be prepared to make specific factual objections. The fee for an appeal is as set forth in LMC 3.104.
