DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Connect Lynnwood: Active and Accessible Transportation Plan and Complete Streets Policy and Implementation (ERC-009822-2021)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Lynnwood SEPA Responsible Official has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS) for the following proposal.

Project Description:

On May 27, 2020, Amie Hanson, Public Works Project Manager with the City of Lynnwood, submitted an application for a SEPA threshold determination for the Connect Lynnwood: Active and Accessible Transportation Plan and Complete Streets Policy and Implementation. This is a non-project action. The Connect Lynnwood plan is intended to guide development and delivery of active transportation projects and meet Lynnwood's transportation goals.

Location: Citywide

Comments and Appeals:

This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340 (2)(c); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issue. Comments must be submitted by **June 30, 2021**. This DNS becomes on **July 14, 2021**, unless the determination is withdrawn or amended by the City's SEPA Responsible Official.

You may appeal this determination by submitting an appeal to the Community Development Department at 20816 44th Ave W, Suite 230, Lynnwood, WA 98036. An appeal may be submitted only after the close of the comment period but no later than **July 14, 2021**, which is 14 days from the end of the comment period. Be prepared to make specific factual objections. The fee for an appeal is as set forth in LMC 3.104.
