

Foundation Plan Requirements

The foundation plan is a detailed drawing of the building foundation, as seen from above. It is drawn to-scale (suggested scale is $\frac{1}{4}$ " = 1') on a minimum of 11x17" paper, with dimensions and other important information, including:

BASIC INFORMATION AS REQUIRED ON SITE PLAN

STRUCTURE INFORMATION

Shape and dimensions of all footings, foundation walls, grade beams, pier pads or anything that will be masonry block or poured concrete.
Location and size of all beams and posts.
Floor system joist size, spacing, grade and species of lumber, direction and length of span(s), and any supports or hangers.
Locations and sizes of all crawlspace vents, access holes, door "blockouts," etc.
Location of any furnace, water heater, sewer ejector pump, drainage sump pump or any other
