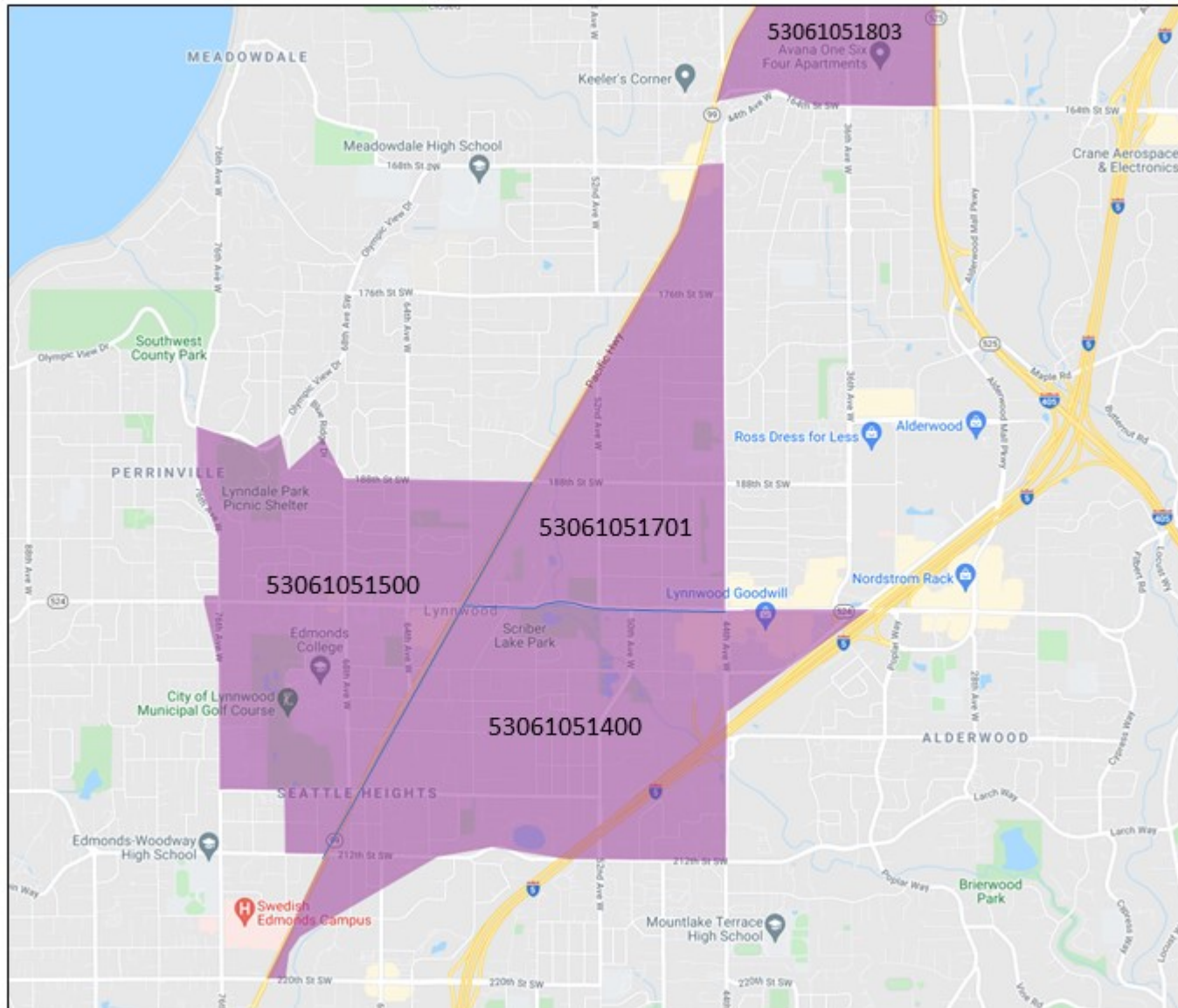

Qualified Census Tracts (QCT) 2021 & 2022, Lynnwood

Housing & Urban Development, Office of Policy Development & Research (PD&R)



QCT: A census tract (or equivalent geographic area defined by the Census Bureau) in which at least 50% of households have an income less than 60% of the area median gross income. In addition, it may also be a Qualified [Census Tract](#) if it has a poverty rate of at least 25%.
