Hi Lynn,

We have an upcoming capital project that would be eligible for ARPA funds as it is in a qualifying census tract – Scriber Lake Park Boardwalk Trail.

Here's a brief project overview:

The scope of this project is to design and construct approximately 1,100 linear feet of elevated boardwalk trail and up to three viewpoints over water. This project is key to providing year-round recreation and ADA access to the City's only lake. Upgrades will also include improving the connections to the existing floating dock, interpretive signage, seating, wetland restoration/enhancements, and parking lot improvements.

Timeline: Design and engineering will begin in 2022 with construction anticipated in 2024 with completion by 2025.
Anticipated Project Cost: \$3 million

This project addresses major maintenance, adds capacity by creating reliable year-round use, and is an accessibility project by addressing barriers.

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
