- General Park Regulations**
- Lynnwood's parks are open from dawn to dusk unless otherwise posted.
  - Unauthorized sale of merchandise, food or services is prohibited.
  - Motorized vehicles are allowed only in designated parking areas.
  - Graffiti and destruction of park property or vegetation is not allowed.
  - Unscheduled team play is not permitted at athletic complexes.
  - Dogs must be on a leash (except in designated areas) and waste picked up.
  - Alcohol, drugs, fireworks, open fires, garbage dumping, livestock, overnight camping, soliciting and misconduct are not permitted in our parks.

Lynnwood is committed to an ecological approach to pest management in all city parks, to protect park users, promote healthy plants and minimize pest problems.


For our kids and the enjoyment of all park users and guests, all Lynnwood parks are clean air zones. Thank you!
