## 30 APPROVAL OF MINUTES – November 21, 2018 Special Meeting

Motion made by Board Member Frizzell, seconded by Board Vice President Hurst, to approve the minutes of the November 21, 2018 Special TBD Meeting as presented. Motion passed unanimously.

60. CONSIDERATION, DISCUSSION, AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON RESOLUTION #10 -

AMEND THE TBD CHARTER

City Engineer David Mach made the staff presentation related to this resolution. Staff is proposing adding a sentence to section 5.04 which would give the Board President the ability to cancel or schedule a meeting. This clarifies how the Board is already functioning.

1 Motion made by Board Member Ross, seconded by Board Member Hurst, to adopt Resolution 10, "A RESOLUTION OF THE LYNNWOOD TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT 2 3 DISTRICT; RELATING TO THE DISTRICT'S CHARTER; AMENDING SECTION 5.04 OF 4 RESOLUTION NO. 1." 5 6 Board members discussed the motion. 7 8 Motion passed unanimously. 9 10 70. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION – INITIATIVE 976 UPDATE 11 12 Engineering Manager Mach gave an update on Initiative 976 as requested by Board Member 13 Hurst and as contained in the packet on page 70-1. The initiative proposed by Tim Eyman 14 will likely appear on the November 2019 ballot and would limit the annual vehicle license tab fees to \$30 total. He discussed how this would impact the TBD with a reduction in 15 annual revenue of \$1.2 million. It would not impact the sales tax portion of the TBD's 16 revenue. Voter approved tab fees would still be allowed. 17 18 19 Board President Cotton asked staff to keep the TBD Board apprised of any need to prepare a 20 ballot measure to backfill for the shortfall. Engineering Mach explained that the money 21 coming is primarily for pavement preservation and repairs. It will have a significant impact to the budget, and a revised plan will need to be created. The predominant amount of this 22 23 funding goes to pavement overlays. The chip seal program was also funded by this last 24 summer. 25 26 Board Member Frizzell asked if the City would continue with the pavement projects already 27 in the budget until this passes. Engineering Manager Mach confirmed that they would. If the 28 ballot measure passes it would go into effect in 2020 and would not affect the current TBD 29 budget as it is a one-year budget. It would, however, impact the City's budget because the 30 City has a two-year budget. He discussed how the two budgets work together. 31 32 Board Member Frizzell asked if the scheduled paving on 68<sup>th</sup> would impact the gold course. Engineering Manager Mach stated that the City will be paving north of the roundabout 33 34 which may impact the golf course. He indicated that the City will coordinate with the golf 35 course and Premier Golf. 36 37 80.
